

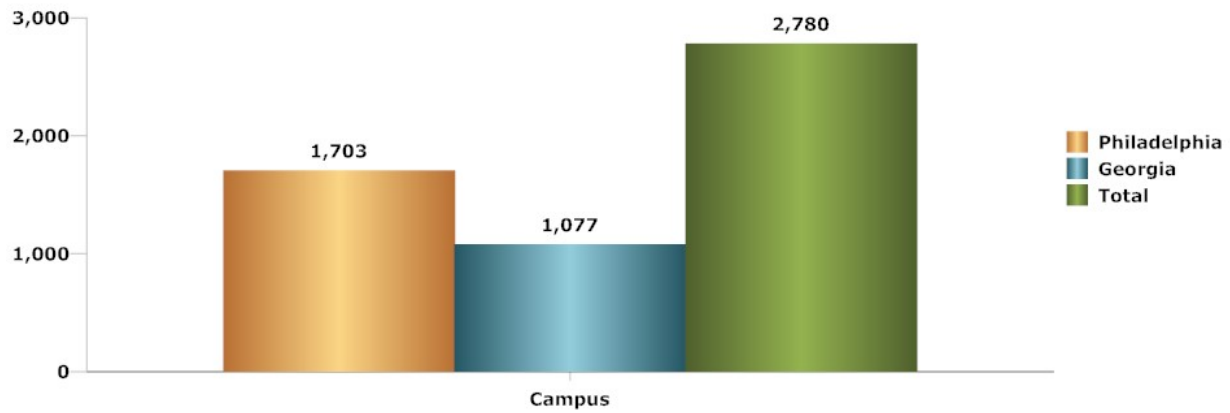

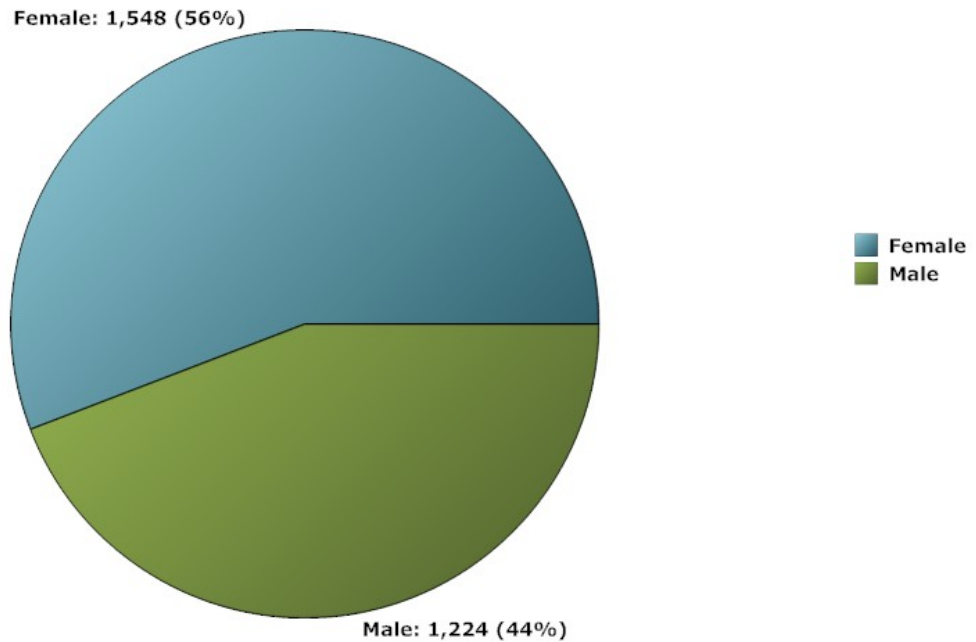

Institutional Total Enrollment 2015

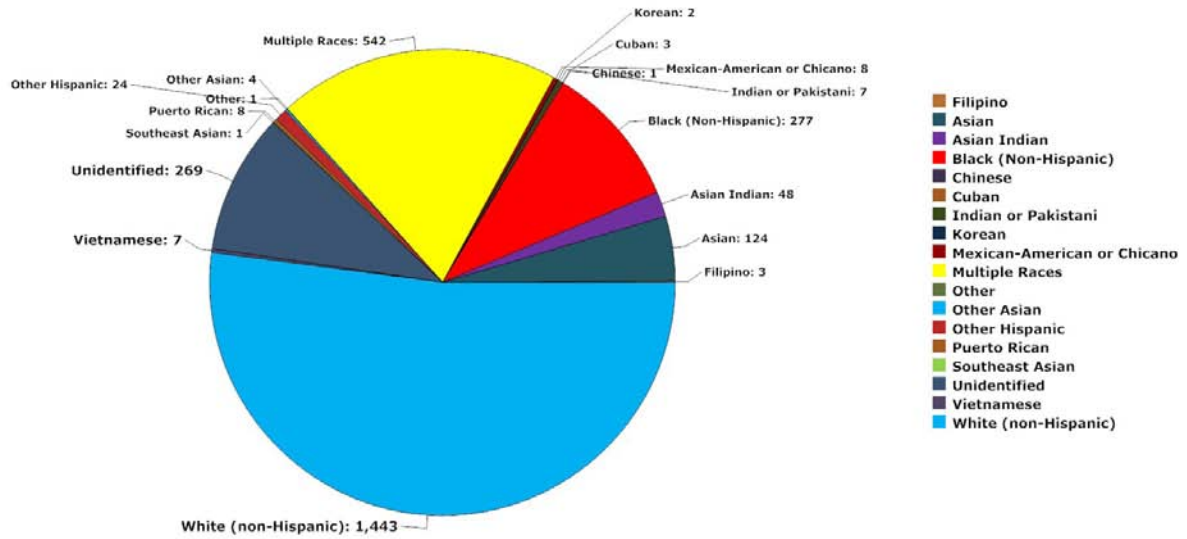


PCOM Philadelphia & Georgia campuses: Gender*



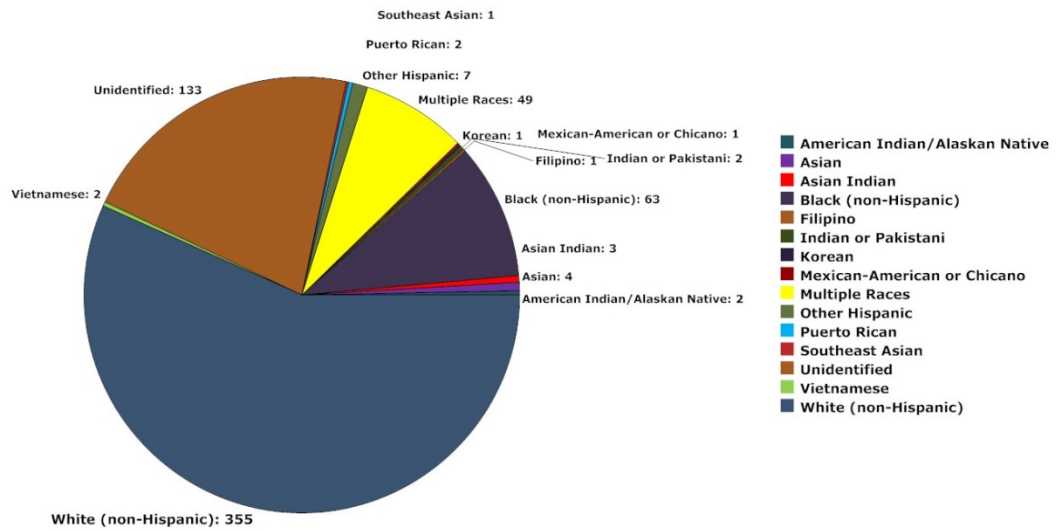

PCOM Philadelphia & Georgia campuses: Ethnicity*



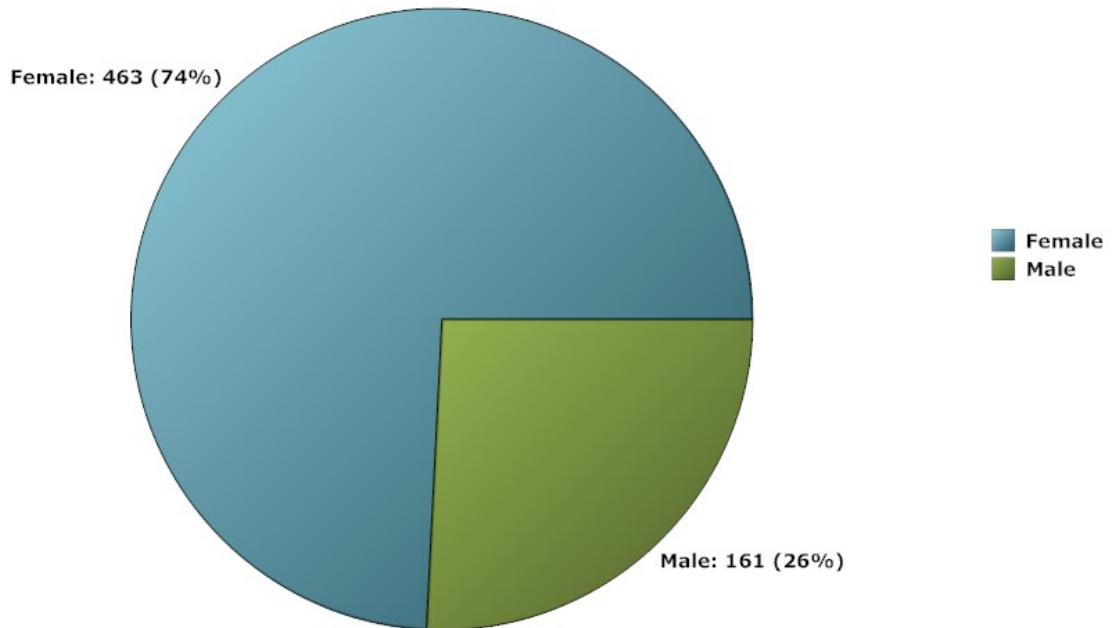

Graduate Programs Philadelphia campus: Ethnicity*



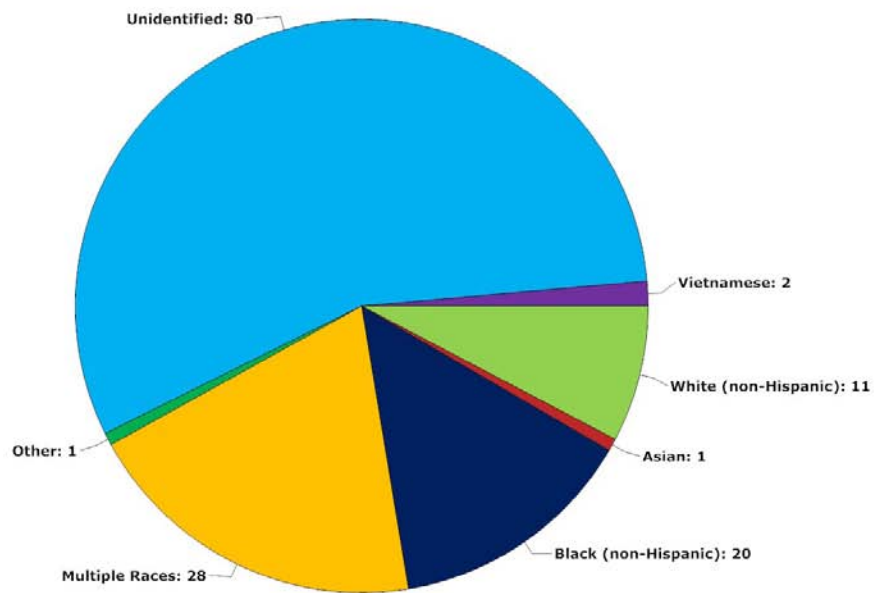

PCOM Graduate Programs Philadelphia campus: Gender*



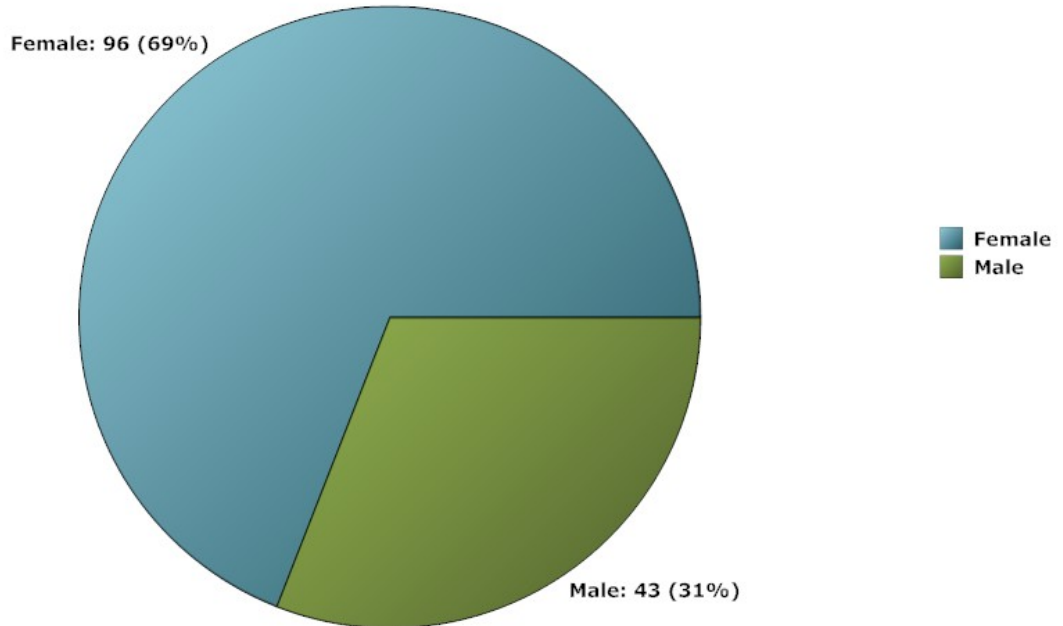
